We set up a board with words from Luke 6: 19 about Jesus healing the sick and now children know that if they would like to pray for anyone to be healed they can come, write the person's name on a plaster and stick the plaster to the board.

If you would like a structure, try this:

- Watch one of the videos or find the story in a children's Bible story book.
- Both the woman who was bleeding and Jairus didn't know what to do except find Jesus. As you colour the attached sheet together, talk about things that seem 'in the depths'. Jesus is ready to listen to us no matter how desperate things seem.
- Listen to the prayer song as you create a prayer board together. You might want to write the names of your local hospitals on the board and pray for the medical staff in them.
- Keep a box of sticking plasters near your prayer board. Write the name of anyone who is ill on a plaster and stick it on the board.
- Finish by saying The Lord's Prayer together.
